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

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Aims and objectives of NORPART

- Strengthened partnerships for education and research between developing countries and Norway
- Increased quality and internationalisation
- Increased mobility of students from
 - developing countries to Norway
 - Norway to developing countries



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Current NORPART projects 2017-2021

- Policy and governance Studies in South Asia
 - Dep Admin & Org Theory
- Health Systems and Health Care Zambia.
 - Dep global health and Social medicine
- Health Economics Bergen – Muhimbili
 - Dep global health and Social medicine
- **Students coming in:** 39 over three years,
 - **going out:** zero (0)



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Norpart 2019-2023

- NORCAM (Foreign languages)- Cameroon
- Pharmacy –Tanzania
- Dentistry – East Africa (Ethiopia, Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda)



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What did we loose?

- Quota scheme – whole degree students
 - For MA and Phd students from Africa, Eastern Europe and Eastern Asia
 - Discontinued and gradually phased out from 2016–2017



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What did UiB and our partners loose?

- University of Bergen had 1255 quota students in period 1994-2019
 - About 94 per year
- Framework of contact at institutional and individual academic level
- Training for high level positions in home country

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



